#### ABOUT THE COMPANY

*Sabina Gold & Silver Corp. is a well-financed Canadian precious metals company on track to become a mid-tier gold producer. #### ABOUT THE POSITION

Working in a remote camp setting on a rotational basis (3x3), the Millwright works with the Site Services team to perform the assembly, installation, maintenance, and repair of varying site services equipment. Reporting to the Site Services Supervisor or designate, the Millwright is responsible for inspecting, servicing, and repairing equipment to ensure safe and efficient use. The Millwright provides support for maintenance systems to the surface team by diagnosing areas of improvement, completing scheduled/unscheduled maintenance, and repair of related equipment while promoting and complying to Sabina's safety procedures and policies. The Millwright assists other tradespeople and the Site Services team in inspecting equipment, diagnosing general areas of repair, installation and maintenance of piping systems which may include boiler units, pressure vessels including regulatory documentation regarding work completed when required. Journeyperson Boilermakers are welcome to apply.

#### PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Supervisor, Site Services duties will include (but are not limited to):

- Assemble, install, align, service and repair site service equipment, including (but not limited to) pumps, fans, tanks, generators, heating equipment, small engine equipment, general plumbing, incinerator, and facility equipment (kitchen, dry's, bathrooms, workshops);
- Diagnose, repair, and complete scheduled and unscheduled maintenance of equipment as required;
- Fitting, welding, and cutting as required;
- Read, understand, and interpret prints to complete required work in a safe and efficient manner. Provide support for maintenance systems in surface environment;
- Inspect equipment for proper performance. Adjust, repair, and diagnose areas of improvement;
- Document and report on repairs, maintenance, and diagnosis on all work completed;
- Operate mobile equipment as required. Manage incoming calls from operators and assist with troubleshooting;
- Participate in toolbox safety meetings to promote compliance with Sabina's safety procedures and policies; and
- Other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

#### DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate will have experience working in remote settings with limited access to resources. Additionally, they will have:

- Interprovincial Red Seal Millwright certification or Nunavut Industrial Mechanic CoQ, with preference given to those with a dual ticket as a Journeyperson Boilermaker;
- Two (2) to five (5) years' post-qualification experience in an industrial, construction, or mining environment, with preference given to those with experience working in remote camp settings with limited access to resources;
- High School Diploma or equivalent considered an asset;
- Valid drivers license; and
- Associated certifications, such as (but not limited to) Overhead Crane, Aerial Work Platform (AWP), rigging certificates, HEO Ticket, Pipe Fusing, or related considered an asset.
