#### **PURPOSE:**

To construct various earthworks designs using various heavy equipment.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES:** In this position the (Multi) Heavy Equipment Operator will:

- Operate Heavy Equipment in a safe and efficient manner, operate two-way radios and report any mechanical issues.
- Conduct pre & post operational inspections on equipment, clean, lubricate and refill equipment.
- Follow all safety protocols with a desire to work cooperatively as part of a productive team.
- Report all deficiencies to supervisor.
- Demonstrate an ability to understand and execute oral and written instructions.
- Able to lift up to 50 lbs. Able to work outdoors in all-weather conditions. Physically fit to perform all aspects of job.

#### **WORKING PREMISES:**

- Remote Construction Site Goose Lake Nunavut Canada, travel to/from site is required, Schedule/Shift: 3 weeks on / 3 weeks off (12-hour shifts)
- Working outdoors in all weather conditions, including extreme cold. Uneven ground, working around heavy equipment, and working near explosives (AN).
