ABOUT THE POSITION

Reporting to the Director, Engineering the Project Controls Manager is responsible in overseeing the financial planning relating to owner's project teams, external consultants, contractors, and stakeholders to analyze, manage, and forecast costs associated in the planning and financial performance of the Back River Project. The Project Controls Manager provides guidance to Project Controllers to manage quality and design performance targets, schedule planning, continuously develop the Project Execution Plan, and financial performance. Preference given to candidates located in Vancouver.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Director, Engineering or Designate, duties will include (but are not limited to):

- Support the Director, Engineering in the planning, organizing, directing, controlling, and evaluation the financial function of the project;
- Collaborate with Finance, Permitting and Environmental, Exploration and Site teams to ensure adherence to the cost, schedule, and established objectives relating to the Back River Project;
- Lead and continuously develop project planning and scheduling activities processes and procedures;
- Provide guidance to Project Controllers to manage quality and design performance targets, schedule planning, Project Execution Plan, and financial performance;
- Develop and maintain key external relationships with consultants, EPC contractors, and external stakeholders;
